國立臺灣大學人類學系 94 學年度第二學期 歷史考古學導論

課程介紹:

北美洲的考古學界中對於歷史考古學的定義,通常限定在地理大發現以後歐洲人種在世界各地 的殖民史。這種方向的研究,固然有其值得批評的問題存在,但回顧臺灣的歷史發展,某種程 度上也是歷經十七世紀以後荷蘭、西班牙、日本及中國等勢力的外來殖民。在這樣的理解下, 臺灣與美洲、非洲及東南亞地區在歷史進程上又有許多共通性,因而在考古學的研究上便有值 得參考借鏡的地方。過去臺灣考古學在處理歷史時期時候的理論及方法主要是延用於史前考古 學,但這樣的處理方式往往忽略歷史材料的處理及與其他學科對話的空間。事實上,臺灣歷史 時期的考古,不管在田野技術(尤其是層位及定年)、理論及方法論都應與史前考古學有相當程 度的差異。

-學期三學分的討論課,除了對大學部學生引介北美洲的歷史考古學思想、理論及方 本味怪為一學期二學分別的語識,除了到人學的學生另分工美術的歷史考古學思想、理論及分法外,也著重於臺灣材料的介紹,特別是臺灣特有的碑刻、口傳歷史、文獻記載、地圖及影像等記錄,以期啟發學生對於臺灣歷史時期考古學的興趣。本課程以大學部三年級以上及研究所碩士班學生為主要授課對象,修習本課的同學必須閱讀每週必讀的參考書目,並參與課堂討 論。每週會有三至四位同學負責閱讀參考書目,在課堂上報告並引導同學討論。每位同學必須 繳交兩份作業、一份簡短的研究計劃(附書目),以及口頭(約 20 分鐘)及書面期末報告。
