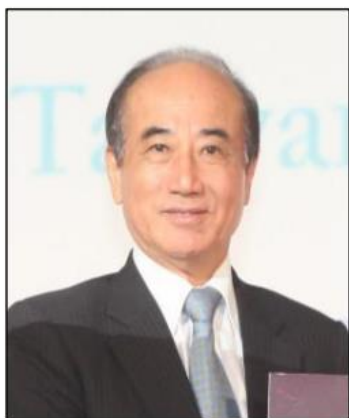

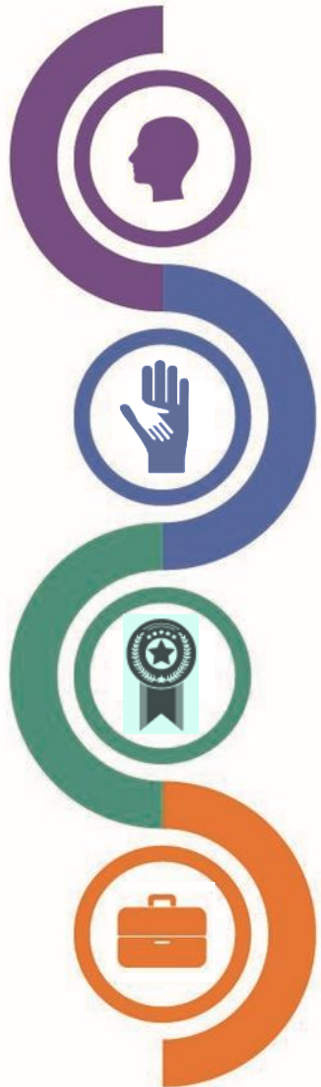

Over 27 years, it has engaged 320 medical institutions and 680 biomedical companies, reviewing 5,000 products and services.

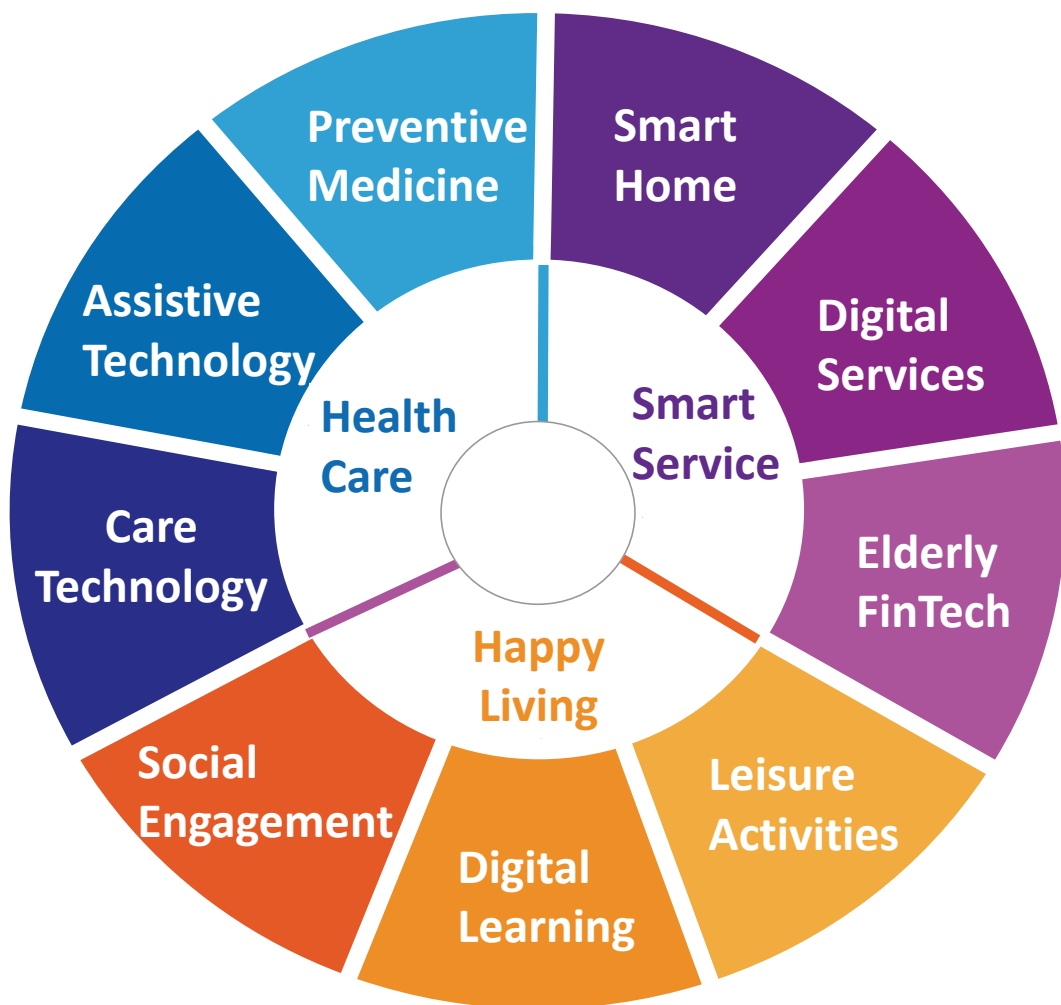

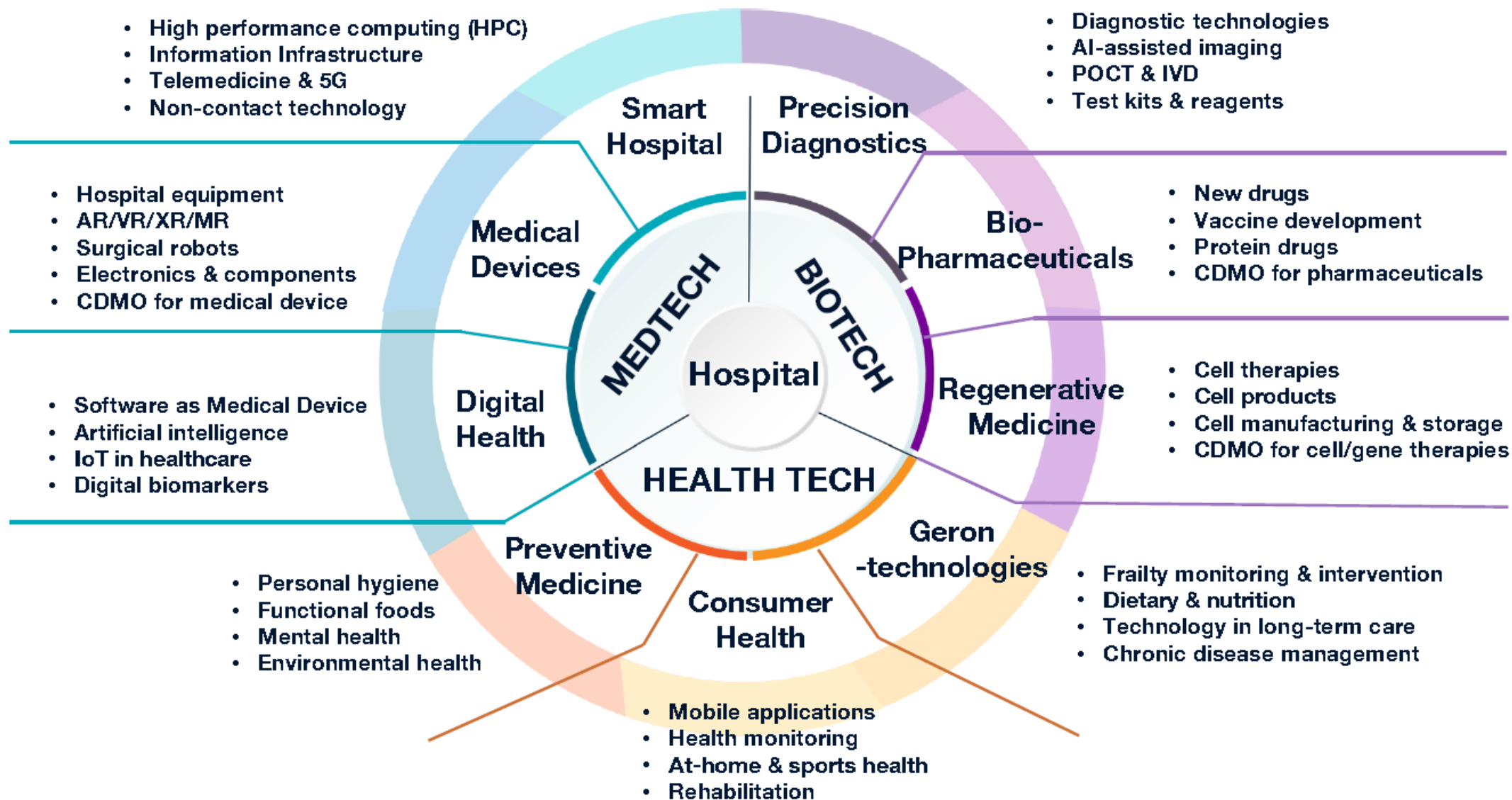

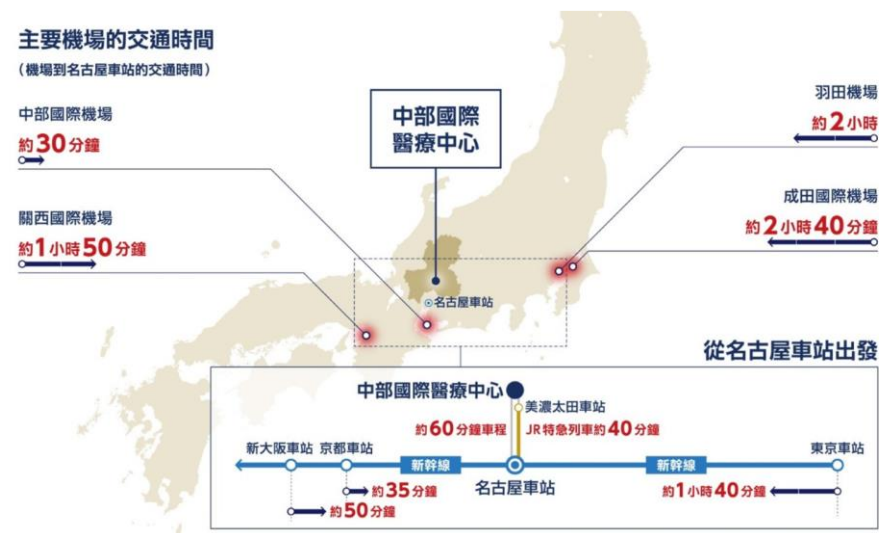
