## Remark

\* This requirement is waived for exchange and visiting students who are from native-English-speaking countries. Exchange students and visiting students who are from English-medium institutions can provide a certifying letter from the home university as proof of their proficiency in English.

## Proof of International Health Insurance

\*\* A proof of International health insurance policy (in English only) must cover hospital inpatient (IPD), outpatient (OPD), accident, and COVID-19 treatment at the private hospitals, issued by an insurance company that is widely recognized in Thailand, such as Generali, FWD General Insurance, AXA, Allianz, Tokio Marine Insurance, or AIA Group. The insurance issued by recognized insurance that has an office in Thailand will facilitate your medical consultation and treatment from the private hospital without advance payment during your stay in Thailand.

### Special Note

At MUIC, exchange and visiting students cannot enroll in research project classes (science) and internships. Additionally, not all courses listed in the course catalog are offered every term, and exchange students may need approval from program directors to register for classes that require prerequisite courses.

## Academic overview

MUIC academic calendar operates on a trimester system. Each trimester has 12 weeks of lecture classes and one week of final exams. Lecture classes are scheduled everyday between 8:00 - 18:00 hrs. Classes usually take place for two hours/day twice per week. Each course is worth 4 MUIC credits with equaling 48 hours of lectures.

## Course load

Inbound students can sign up for a minimum of 12 credits (mostly equivalent to three subjects). The standard course load per trimester is 16 credit hours.

An evaluation of a student's academic achievement is recorded by letter grades.

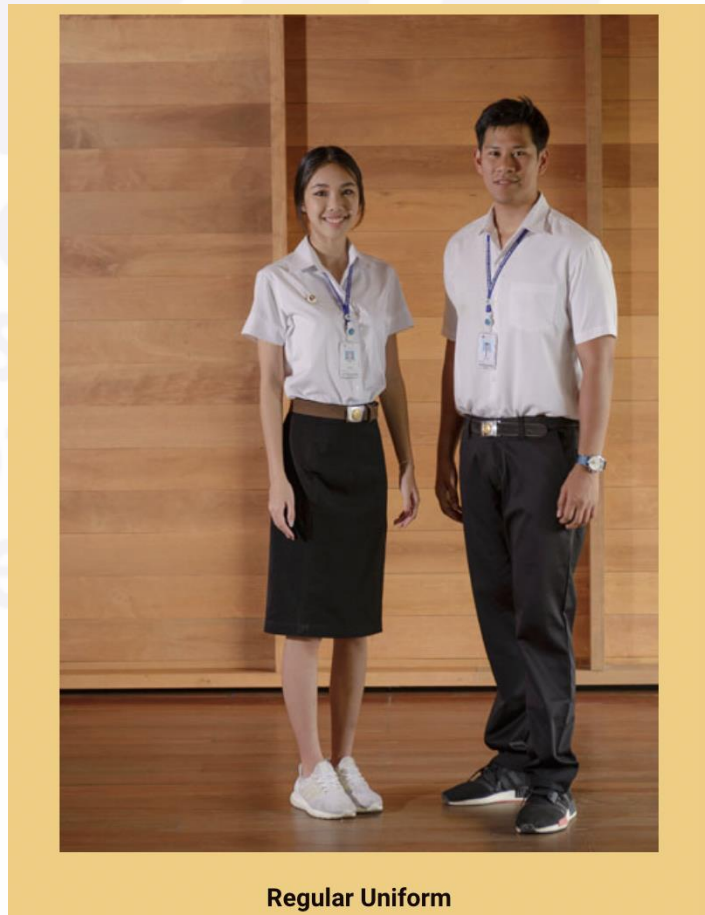


## Visa Information

All students are required to obtain a student visa before entering Thailand. A supporting letter from MUIC will be forwarded to the university coordinator for the students to use when applying for an education visa at the Royal Thai Embassy in the student's country. MUIC does not assist students in applying for a work permit or part-time job

## Uniform

Students must wear the regular uniform while attending classes at MUIC and anywhere else on campus. Uniforms can be purchased at the college, or students may bring white button-front shirts and black skirts for females or white button-front shirts and black trousers for males. Students must also wear plain black shoes or plain sport shoes.

Getting to the Bangkok Mass Transit System commonly known as the BTS or the Skytrain from Mahidol University – Salaya Campus, the Salaya Link is a shuttle bus service which leaves from the College of Music to “Bang Wa” BTS station.
