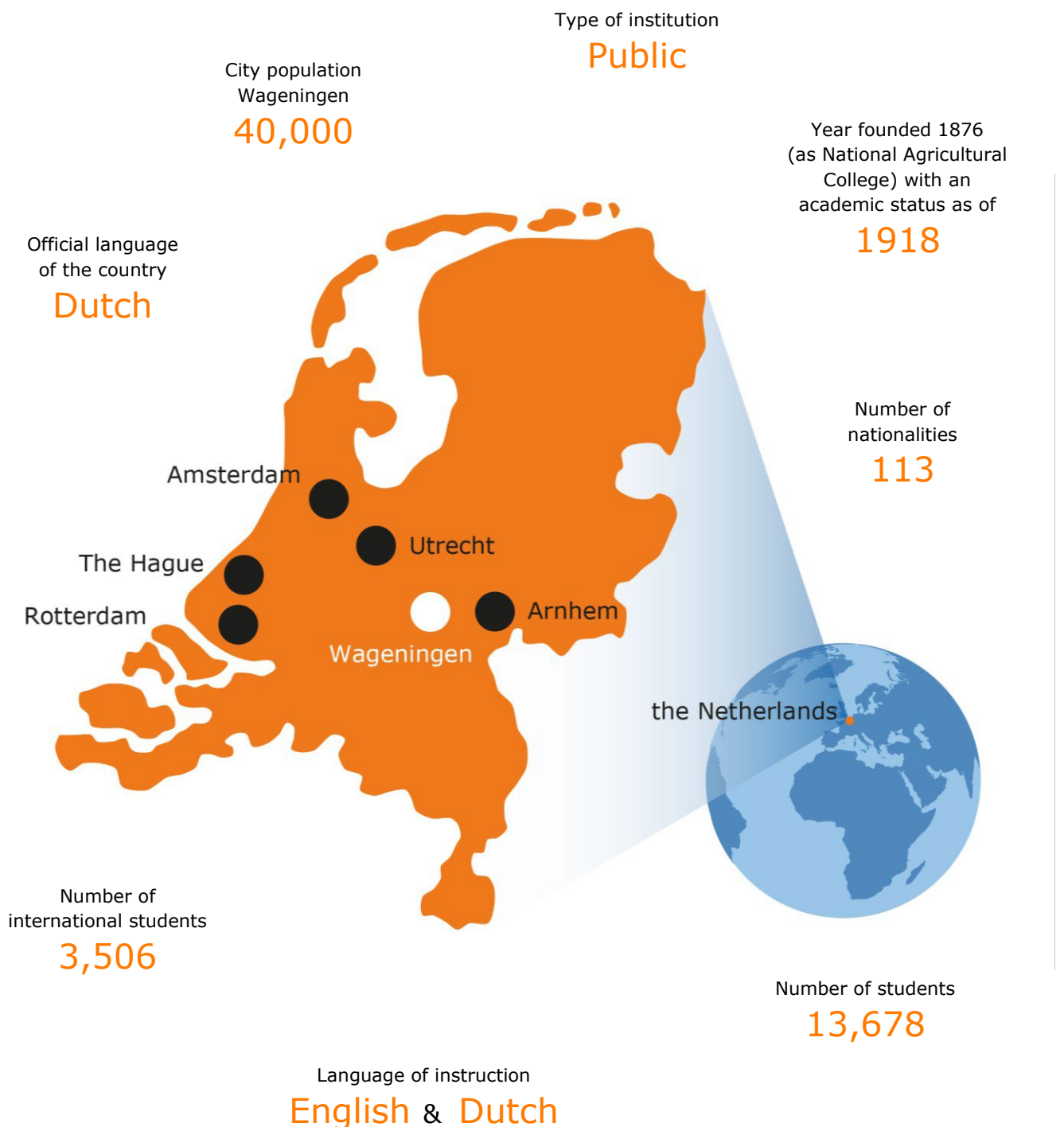

## Eligibility for exchange

### Inter-institutional agreement

There should be an inter-institutional agreement for Student Mobility for Study (SMS) between the home university and Wageningen University & Research.

### Registration

Exchange students should be registered as a regular student at one of the partner universities.

### General course requirements

Preferably you have completed 120 ECTS, which equals at least two years two years of study at the home university/academic background.

### English proficiency (minimum scores)

- TOEFL internet-based: 80
- IELTS : 6.0
- Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English: C
- Cambridge First Certificate: B
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English: C
- German Abitur: 06
- Belgian ADO or TSO: 60
- International Baccalauréat: 3

### Other requirements

Students must fulfil course requirements (assumed knowledge in course descriptions).

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## Housing

As we have a shortage of housing, the number of rooms allocated to exchange students is very limited. In most cases housing is guaranteed for non-EU students because of immigration rules. ## Immigration information

For some incoming students, Wageningen University & Research needs to apply for a MVV entry visa and/or residence permit (VVR) after admittance (students should not start procedures themselves). The Student Immigration Office of the Student Service Centre (SSC) from Wageningen University & Research will send the application for entry visa (MVV) and/or residence permit (VVR) to the immigration authorities (IND). The dues for this procedure are € 210 (2023). In this table you can check which permit(s) are needed.
